

The production of non-metallic minerals for CY 2018 represents 5.12% of the overall mineral production (Figure 7).

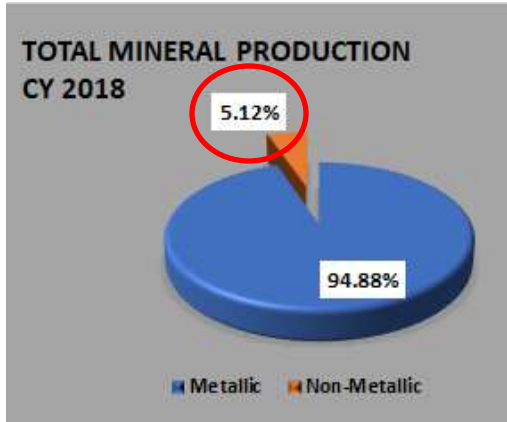

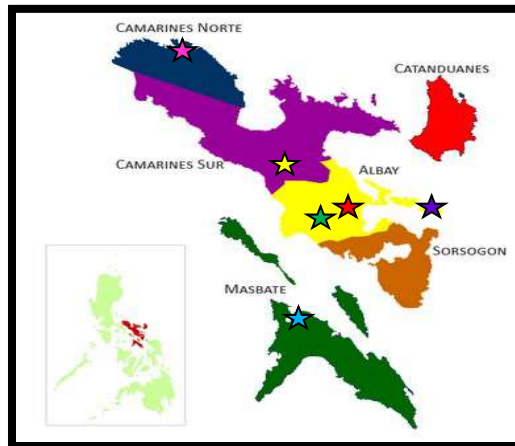

BICOL REGION MINERAL STATISTICS CY 2018

The Bicol Mining Industry

The mining industry plays a vital role in the country's economic and community growth. It also provides employment, revenues and contributes to the country's foreign exchange through exports.

The Bicol Region is rich in mineral resources ranging from gold, to silver, copper, marble, manganese, chromite, nickel, sand and gravel.

METALLIC PRODUCTION

For 2018, the gold production of Bicol Region has increased by 13% from P12.99 Billion in 2017 to P14.58 Billion (Figure 1).

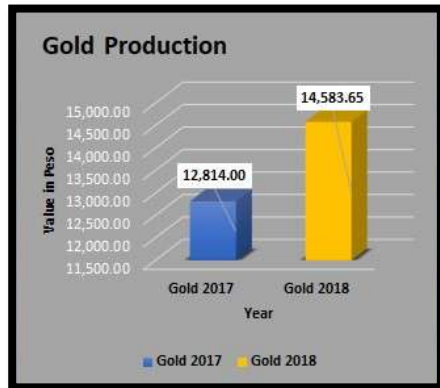

Silver production fell by 29% which is valued at P130.93 Million in 2018 from 2017's silver production valued at P183.18 Million (Figure 2).

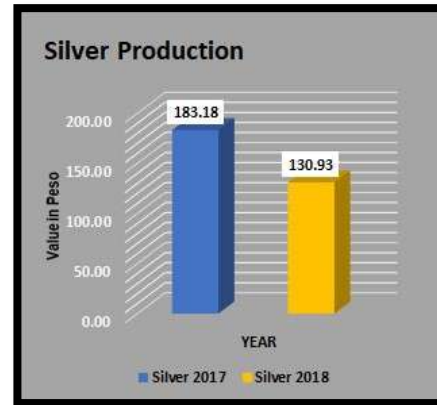

The overall metallic production of Bicol Region has increased by 12% in 2018 which valued at P14.58 Billion (Figure 3).

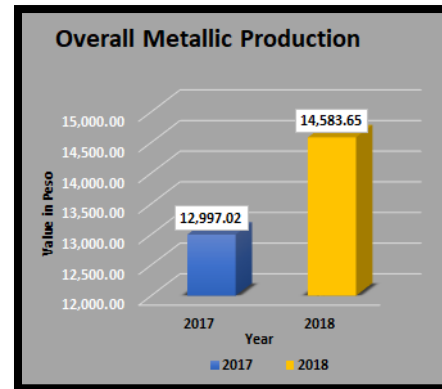

The total metallic production for CY 2018 represents 94.88% of the overall mineral production. (Figure 4)

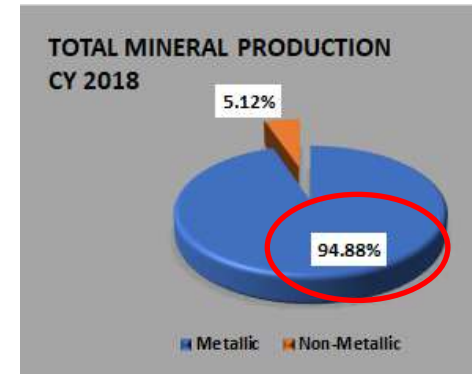

NON- METALLIC PRODUCTION

In 2018, the production of non-metallic minerals such as aggregates, boulder, earth fill, limestone, perlite, pumice, sand and gravel, shale clay and white clay has reached 110% growth rate with a value of P785 Million from CY 2017's value P373.48 Million (Figures 5 & 6)

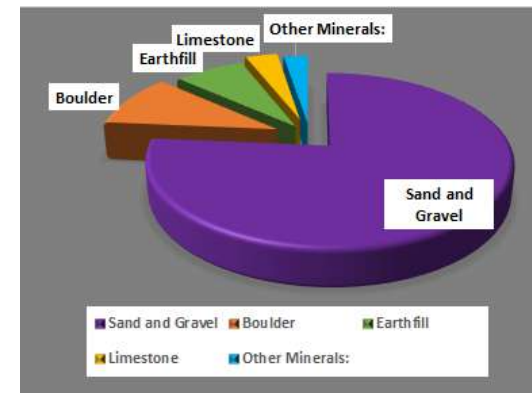
